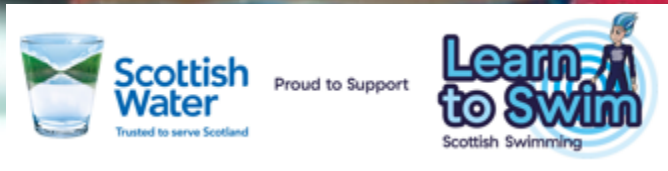

- Provides a teaching and development framework which is defined by latest practice and thinking.
- Allows Swim Dev. Team to access a peer network of support for sharing of initiatives, ideas etc.
- Sets standards around Swimming Teaching performance with regular CPD embedded.
- Focus not purely on swimming strokes but also on the core aquatic skills which underpin them.
- We have softly introduced many aspects of the new programme already to ease transition.

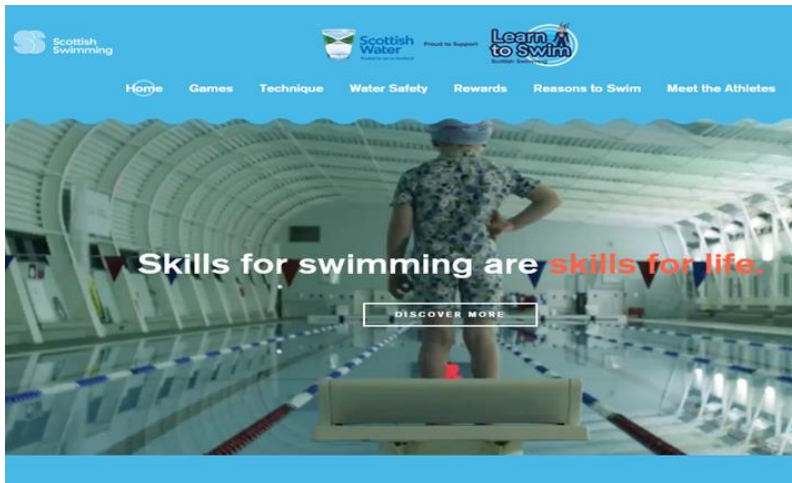
