- The Award Nomination Time Period is from **1st April 2019 – 31st March 2020**. This is time period in which nominations should be based on with the exception of the Outstanding Contribution Award.
- You **MUST** fill out all fields on the form with nominee's details NOT the school or club details.
- You **MUST** have permission from the nominee to submit the form.
- The Awards Event Team will not undertake any further research on the nominee so please be as detailed as possible to ensure each nominee is considered fairly.
- Final Deadline for Nominations is **Friday 10th April 2020**.

Awards Descriptions

Community Coach of the Year

This award will be made to a coach in recognition of their achievements to date. This award looks for coaches who have invested in their development as a coach and have made a significant impact on the people they coach.

Adult Volunteer of the Year

A person (who has left school) who you feel deserves recognition for their outstanding voluntary contribution to sport and physical activity either in the school, club or community setting. This could be a parent, student, non-teaching staff member or community volunteer.

Official of the Year

This award will be made to a sport official in recognition of their achievements to date. This award looks for officials who have invested in their development and have made a significant impact on their chosen sport.

ERCL Coach of the Year

This award category is for a member of coaching staff working within ERCL Community Sport Programme who has made a significant impact on sport, the people they coach and the organisation as a whole.

Young Volunteer of the Year

A pupil in S1-S6 who you feel deserves recognition for their outstanding voluntary contribution to sport and physical activity in your school, their club and/or the community.

Teacher Volunteer of the Year

A teacher who you feel deserves recognition for their outstanding voluntary contribution to sport and physical activity either in the school, club or community setting

Young Ambassadors Award for Excellence

This award recognises a Young Ambassador who has made the greatest impact through promoting and creating sporting opportunities within local schools. This could be an individual or Team of the Young Ambassadors. Nominees must be a recognised sportsScotland Young Ambassador.

Dance Volunteer of the Year

This award is for a pupil who has excelled in the area of dance, has engaged with a school to deliver dance extra-curricular, and promoted dance opportunities to pupils.

Project of the Year

This award recognises an innovative approach which uses sport and physical activity to improve and enhance the quality of life of the residents of East Renfrewshire.

School - Club Link Award

This award is for an East Renfrewshire sport club who has made an outstanding contribution to Active Schools. This will be awarded to a club who has developed strong links with local schools and delivered activities, training and events leading to more children and young people becoming active within East Renfrewshire.

Outstanding Contribution to Sport Award

The Outstanding Contribution to Sport Award aims to showcase and celebrate the achievement of an individual who has contributed to the development of school, club or community sport over a prolonged period of time.

Award Specific Information

Volunteer Awards

- The voluntary activities carried out must be entirely voluntary in nature and no remittance should be received for work detailed in the nomination.
- The voluntary hours must be over and above any work placements/experience and compulsory coursework hours.
- The voluntary hours can include all activities both in and out of school. For example, a pupil or teacher may volunteer 3 hours a week at their school's afterschool dance club and also volunteer 2 hours per week helping to coach at the local community netball club.

Additional Information

The awards team reserve the right to change the category in which someone is nominated if they are more suited to that category based on details in the nomination. The decision of the awards team is final and no appeals will be accepted.
